## Natural Progression

Fower shape is essential to this arrangement's success. We picked lilies for their gentle outward curve, dahlias for their loosely arrayed petals, and leucadendron for its layered look


## Step

To create the first layer of calla lilies, trim stems so that the base of the bloom is an inch or less from the top of the vase.


## Step

Use dahlias to create your second tier of flowers, cutting stems so that blooms stand just above the lilies. Line the flowers around the inside of the circle of lilies.

Materials 'Safari Goldstrike' leucadendron, orange dahlias, 'Black Beauty' calla lilies, scissors, and two containers of different heights (we used antiqued glass vases)


Step

Strip the bottom leaves off of the leucadendron so that they don't crowd the vase and dirty the water.


## Step



Cut stems of leucadendron so that they are tall enough to rise a few inches above the dahlias. Fill a couple stems into the remaining space at the vase's center.
